Our office is committed to serving every DuPage County resident with transparency, efficiency, and integrity. We collect and distribute over \$3.8 billion in property taxes each year — funds that directly support your schools, parks, public safety, and essential county services.

I can report that the DuPage County assessed value increased by 8.2% with a 4.37% decrease in the average tax rate, resulting in an overall DuPage County property tax bill increase of 3.83%. Depending on where you live, your individual bill could be higher or lower.

We are especially dedicated to serving our senior citizens, ensuring they have easy access to exemptions, payment assistance, and the information they need to navigate the property tax process with confidence.

We work hard to make paying your taxes as simple as possible, offering multiple convenient payment options, understandable bills, and responsive customer service. We also safeguard county investments. Our team actively returns unclaimed funds to residents.

Write your 10-digit PIN on your check. Use provided envelopes before Sept 30. Keep bottom stub as receipt.

June 1, 2026	1st Installment Due
Sept 1, 2026	2nd Installment Due
Oct 2, 2026	Deadline to avoid publication of delinquent taxes
Oct 30, 2026	Last day before certified funds required
Nov 2, 2026	Certified funds required
Nov 18, 2026	Certified payment deadline by 4:30 pm to avoid Tax Sale
Nov 19, 2026	2025 Property Tax Sale begins
